Dedication Sunday ~ During today's worship service we bring our pledge cards to the front of the Sanctuary, and place them in baskets to be dedicated to Highland's ministry and mission during 2025.

The baskets are a symbol of abundance. In Matthew's Gospel, we are told that when Iesus fed five thousand men (plus uncounted women and children) from five loaves and two fish, there were twelve baskets of leftovers (Matt. 14:16-21). In another account, four thousand men (plus women and children) were fed from seven loaves and a few small fish, and the leftovers filled seven baskets (Matt. 15: 33-39). Our blessings are abundant indeed, and it is fitting for us to use these baskets to return some of our abundance to the Lord. Together with our time and our talents, our monetary gifts help make this church's ministry thrive and grow.
